


About Us

We endeavor to provide the learning environment and guidance needed to prepare children with language difficulties to communicate effectively, live their lives happily, and to reach their full potential.




Small Talk Centre for Language Development

What Happens in the Centre?

We have four, half-day therapy programs, operating Tuesdays through Fridays.

We offer dynamic, specialized preschool instruction; experiential and visual learning experiences; and we promote language learning through therapeutic play.


We also offer speech and language assessment for children in attendance, caregiver consultation, caregiver workshops and outreach to other learning centres.

Annual program fees are payable in monthly installments.


Support is available for those who would benefit from financial assistance.



Is My Child Eligible?

Small Talk Centre is open to:

- + Children of families who live in Vancouver
- + Children diagnosed by a Speech and Language Pathologist (SLP) with a language delay or disorder
- + Children whose language learning needs are best served in a group setting (5:1 child-teacher ratio)
- + Children whose language delays exist in their first language



How Do I Register My Child?

Small Talk only accepts referrals from certified Speech and Language Pathologists (SLPs). If you or your health-care provider have concerns about your child's language development, please first have your child assessed by an SLP.

Referrals must be faxed to our centre by your existing SLP, with your child's recent assessment reports attached.

Once a referral is received, Small Talk will contact you to arrange an initial consultation appointment.
